Benefits of joining Ekonk Hill Turkey Farm, CSA

- CSA, or Community Supported Agriculture offers the opportunity to support local, family farms by becoming a member of the farm. Members buy into the farm at the beginning of the season and become partners with the farm in growing the food you eat.
- CSA members receive a **first priority** share of the farm’s limited all natural pasture-raised poultry, meats, or eggs in return for their investment in the farm.
- By supporting Ekonk Hill Turkey Farm you are supporting your local economy and benefiting the environment since your food does not need to be shipped from far away.

I would like to reserve the following shares in Ekonk Hill Turkey Farm’s CSA:

Please note that all CSA memberships (6 or 12-month) begin in June to coincide with the farm’s crop season. Enrollment period is Jan – May 6-month shares run from June – November and 12 month shares run from June 2010 to May 2011.

- #1 **6-Month POULTRY Share** (6 monthly distributions of 20 pounds of home grown chicken plus a 20-pound fresh pasture-raised Ekonk Hill Thanksgiving Turkey) - **\$475**
- #2 **12-Month POULTRY Share** (12 monthly distributions of 20 pounds of home grown chicken plus a 20-pound fresh pasture-raised Ekonk Hill Thanksgiving Turkey and one 10-pound Christmas Capon) - **\$925**
- #3 **6-Month MEAT Share** (6 monthly distributions of 20 pounds of home grown meats including 8 pounds of chicken, 4 pounds of hamburger, 2 pounds of pork sausage, and 6 pounds of assorted chops, steaks, or roasts) - **\$750**
- #4 **12-Month MEAT Share** (12 monthly distributions of 20 pounds of home grown meats including 8 pounds of chicken, 4 pounds of hamburger, 2 pounds of pork sausage, and 6 pounds of assorted chops, steaks, or roasts) - **\$1,475**
- #5 **6-Month “TASTE OF CT” Share** (6 monthly distributions of 1 pt maple syrup, 1 lb of honey, 1 lb farmstead cheese, 2 jars preserves, 1 doz free-range eggs, 2 pints farmstead yogurt, ½ gallon black currant juice all from local CT farms) - **\$400**
- #6 **12-Month “TASTE OF CT” Share** (12 monthly distributions of 1 pt maple syrup, 1 lb of honey, 1 lb farmstead cheese, 2 jars preserves, 1 doz free-range eggs, 2 pints farmstead yogurt, ½ gallon black currant juice all from local CT farms) - **\$775**
